**\$227,189**

## Community is the Center of our Life:

**\$227,101**

We learned the vital importance of community that is so easily taken for granted during a sustained period of physical separation, but we also discovered new ways of being connected while being apart. In 2021, in addition to increasing participation in Life Groups and neighborhood involvement, we want to intentionally reach out to better include the spiritually curious, the unchurched, and the de-churched by continuing to expand our online ministry.

## Reconciliation is the Center of our Work:

**\$290,710**

2020 revealed the many issues that divide us, and the necessity of Jesus' followers waging peace both within the walls of the church and in the halls of power. As ambassadors of reconciliation, we want to invest in helping people become more like Jesus wherever they are and to love more like Jesus wherever they go. Through God's mission in our neighborhood and beyond, by training leaders in the Micah Project, and sharing our resources with ministries seeking to extend shalom, we're seeking to continue to develop people into everyday peacemakers in 2021.
